

Two or Four Cross Supports?

I've just written McKean Models concerning their #1750 thru #1755 open center beam kits. I had earlier written to you and asked for a photo of a Thrall 68' IL Center Beam car. UP 260108 was shown on page 8 of the *Modern Freight Cars - A Photo Anthology* book. Here's the problem, which to date no one has settled.

The kit includes only two cross support beams with no photos and very little text. I can see that UP 260108 has four cross support beams. Thus the question, is there a prototype that only has two cross support beams? I wrote McKean and they responded with a photo of their assembled kit - which means nothing without prototype confirmation! I'm not about to assemble this kit until I find out if a prototype exists. - *William B. Stanley*
